Na = 23, O = 16, H = 1. (You will be given these numbers in the exam.) Next, divide the atomic number of oxygen by the total atomic number of NaOH, and multiply by 100 to get a percentage. NaOH is 23 + 16 + 1 = 40. (16 ÷ 40) × 100 = 0.4 × 100 = 40%. So the percentage by mass of oxygen in sodium hydroxide is 40%.
