Steps in the guided reading process: Gather information about the readers to identify emphases. Select and analyze texts to use. Introduce the text. Observe children as they read the text individually (support if needed). Invite children to discuss the meaning of the text. Make one or two teaching points. Engage children in letter/word work activity.
