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INTERDISCIPLINARY REHABILITATION AFTER WHIPLASH INJURY: AN ...

A well-functioning interdisciplinary team is aware of the potential effects each members' care and counsel can produce on the goals and strategies of the patient, other team providers, and the overall rehabilitation plan. In the case presented here, members of each professional group worked collaboratively to support and/or facilitate the care of other team members by adapting methods to avoid redundant therapies and enlist the evaluation and/or treatment of needed specialties.

The interdisciplinary team is very common in inpatient spinal cord injury rehabilitation centers. Interdisciplinary teams involve: Professionals involved in joint problem solving; Overlapping, patient focused treatment goals; Collaboration with other disciplines; Regular communication between team members

For example, according to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), interdisciplinary teams in an IRF must meet every seven days, be explicitly lead by a rehabilitation physician, and also include a registered nurse who is trained as a social worker or case manager as well as licensed or certified physical therapists, occupational therapists and speech and language pathologists. 3 All teams utilize goal setting techniques and regular formal communication for coordination and ...

The typical interdisciplinary pain rehabilitation program includes 3 to 4 weeks of treatment lasting 4 to 8 h/d, 5 d/wk. Because many patients have musculoskeletal impairments and have limited ability to be fully functional, patients are guided individually or in a group setting through progressive exercises to reverse the effects of deconditioning.

The fundamental purpose of the acquired brain injury team is to provide the most effective services available to maximize the recovery of the person with acquired brain injury. Collaboration as an interdisciplinary brain injury team, under the leadership of a team coordinator, is intended to improve and optimize patient care and outcomes across the continuum of rehabilitation.
