- Prepare epidural solution: bupivacaine 0.1% with fentanyl 2 mcg/ml •(To prepare 50 ml of this solution, take 38 ml of normal saline into a 50 ml syringe, add 10 ml of 0.5% plain bupivacaine and 100 mcg i.e. 2 ml of fentanyl).
