

WARRANT SERVICE RISK ASSESSMENT SURVEY

Risk assessment is based on facts and circumstances stated in the affidavit for the warrant, criminal history of suspects, target location, the details learned during the target scout, and any intelligence gained from information gathered during the conduct of the investigation.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- ✓ Gather the source documents together, and place a "X" in the block for each numbered element that corresponds.
- ✓ Once the appropriate elements have been "X" off, go to each of the seven categories (A to G) and take **ONLY** the highest point valued element selected in each category, and place it in the **SCORE** column.
- ✓ Now add up the point values in the **SCORE** column for the seven categories and place it in the **TOTAL** box.
- ✓ Compare the **TOTAL** score to the assessment table below to determine actions for service.

NOTE: If there are multiple suspects, the element point value will remain the same as if there was one suspect, though this information should be included/discussed during the formation of the operational plan.
