**ORDER**

This matter came on for hearing February 8, 2007 before the Honorable Justice Gibney, and based upon the psychiatric report of Dr. Andrew S. Rosenzweig and his attached DMAT, and representations of counsel and the guardians, it is hereby:

**ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED**

1. Laurette Borduas Eifrig shall remain a resident of Capitol Ridge, unless there is a medical emergency or other need for hospitalization or skilled nursing care and until further Order of this Court.
2. Both Francine Eifrig Ardito and Suzette Eifrig Gebhard may visit with Laurette Borduas Eifrig at Capitol Ridge in a supervised setting, but neither may remove Laurette Borduas Eifrig from the facility until further Order of this Court.
3. Either Richard A. Boren or Paula Cuculo shall be present during any such visitation.
4. Francine Eifrig Ardito shall be able to visit with Laurette Borduas Eifrig first.
5. Neither Francine Eifrig Ardito nor Suzette Eifrig Gebhard shall visit with Laurette simultaneously and shall coordinate their visitation to avoid contact with each other.
6. Any visitation shall be coordinated through either Richard A. Boren or Paula Cuculo.
7. Neither Francine Eifrig Ardito nor Suzette Eifrig Gebhard shall place any calls or correspond by mail to Laurette Borduas Eifrig until further order of this Court.
8. At any such visitation, neither Francine Eifrig Ardito nor Suzette Eifrig Gebhard shall discuss finances, living arrangements, or the subject of this litigation, with Laurette Borduas Eifrig.

- 9. Francine Eifrig Ardito's daughter, Alicia, may also call or visit with Laurette Borduas Eifrig, said visitation occurring under the same supervised visitation as set forth herein.
- 10. Hermine Borduas of Toronto, Canada may visit with Laurette Borduas Eifrig under the same supervised visitation as set forth herein, but not before the two sisters have been given the opportunity to visit, but Hermine shall not place any telephone calls to Laurette Borduas Eifrig.
- 11. The Order of January 29, 2007 is hereby vacated and this Order shall be substituted in its place.
- 12. Paula Cuculo shall contact Dr. Rosenzweig and request a second evaluation in approximately two (2) weeks.
- 13. Thereafter, the parties shall again set this matter down for a conference before this Honorable Court.


