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NARRATIVE FOR DETECTIVE THOMAS A DIGREGORIO

Ref: 07-2265-AR

On 7/31/07, Alfred Bishop was arraigned in 3rd Division District Court on the charges outlined in this report. See the arrest warrant and affidavit for further details.

Case # 07-2968-OF

On 6/28/07 at approximately 0008 Hrs., members of the Warwick Police Department responded to 43 Warwick Lake Ave. for a reported home invasion with shots having been fired inside the home. On arrival, Officers noticed that all three members of the household had been shot, with the two males present lying in a pool of blood on the kitchen floor. The third party, a female who had contacted 911 and allowed the police entry into the residence, had been shot in the leg.

Rescue arrived and transported all three residents to Rhode Island Hospital for treatment of their injuries. While at the hospital, it was learned that one of the males, identified as Gabriel Medeiros dob 11/10/71, had died as a result of a gun shot wound.

In subsequent investigation, it was learned that the two surviving victims, husband and wife Cesar Medeiros dob 5/29/64 and Claire Medeiros dob 1/23/68, had been sleeping at the time the intruder entered their home. While lying asleep in bed, the victims stated that they first heard their dog barking and repeatedly told the dog to quiet down. When the dog's barking grew louder and failed to stop, the surviving victims got out of bed to investigate the reason for the dog's barking. Mr. Medeiros got out of bed and was the first to exit the bedroom and enter the hallway. Mr. Medeiros stated that, in the dark, he was confronted by a subject approaching his bedroom wearing a ski mask and brandishing a handgun.

Mr. Medeiros spoke first, telling the gunman not to hurt his family. Mr. Medeiros offered to give the gunman money and jewelry which he had stored in his bedroom. The gunman stayed in the hallway while Mr. Medeiros entered the bedroom and grabbed a golf club. Once in the hallway, Mr. Medeiros stated that he struck the gunman in the head and then in the right arm with the golf club in an attempt to dislodge the weapon from the gunman's grasp. During the struggle, Mrs. Medeiros entered the hallway in the vicinity of the struggle. Mrs. Medeiros stated that she turned the hallway light on briefly and noticed her husband struggling with the unknown intruder, described by both victims as being a white male in his mid-to-late 40's, 5-08 to 5-11, thin build with salt-and-pepper hair. At the time the light in the hallway was turned on, the gunman was not wearing the earlier described ski mask and was bleeding from the injury sustained to his head. Mrs. Medeiros stated that she did not recognize the gunman and, as a result, turned the light off in the hallway.

As the struggle ensued, the gunman fired two rounds from his weapon and then retreated down the hallway, through the living room and into the kitchen located to the rear of the residence. Mr. Medeiros stated that he told his wife to stay in the bedroom and then followed the gunman into the kitchen. From the bedroom, Mrs. Medeiros called 911. Mr. Medeiros entered the kitchen and he saw his brother, the deceased, attempt to tackle the gunman at which point the gunman fired a single round at the deceased. Mr. Medeiros stated that his brother tackled the gunman, landing upon him in the area of the slider in the kitchen. Mr. Medeiros stated that the gunman then attempted to get up from underneath the deceased's body at which point Mr. Medeiros, with golf club still in hand, came into the kitchen toward where the gunman lay. Mr. Medeiros stated that the intruder then pointed the gun at him and fired a round striking him in the thigh. Mr. Medeiros, however, continued toward the gunman and attempted to stab the intruder in the abdomen with what he now noticed to be the shaft of the broken golf club. Mr. Medeiros stated, however, that he was on the verge of losing consciousness from his wounds and that the gunman was able to escape through the rear slider of the residence onto an adjacent patio.

Shortly after hearing the struggle end, Mrs. Medeiros stated that she entered the kitchen and noticed her husband and the deceased both lying next to each other on the floor. Mrs. Medeiros stated that she stayed on the phone with 911 until the arrival of police.

It should be noted that Warwick Police BCI personnel, in their search of the residence, were able to locate a ski mask which was stained with blood, a trail of blood droplets leading out of and away from the residence and the broken golf club which was used to strike the intruder, among other items.

After being treated for their injuries at Rhode Island Hospital, Mr. and Mrs. Medeiros met with retired Capt. Linda Eastman who drew a composite sketch of the suspect. This sketch, along with a description of the injuries sustained by the suspect, was released to the media. The media coverage triggered numerous calls from private citizens and members of the law enforcement community with tips to police. Warwick Detectives conducted an investigation which included interviewing witnesses and eliminating potential suspects identified through the tips.

One of the leads which came into the department named the defendant, Alfred Bishop dob 5/27/42 as a potential suspect, based on the composite sketch. It should be noted that Mr. Bishop was released from the ACI in August, 2006 after serving over 30 years for a murder conviction.

During the course of the investigation, it was learned that Mr. Bishop's ex-wife, Marie R. Bishop dob. 4/5/47 resides at 85 Fairway Lane with her mother, Elizabeth Marsoli dob 2/26/22. This address is in close proximity to 43 Warwick Lake Avenue. A witness reported to investigating officers that after seeing gunshot flashes coming from the 43 Warwick Lake Avenue address, that he observed a male figure in the area of 85 Fairway Lane.

On 7/3/07, Warwick Police Detectives, along with RI Probation and Parole, took Mr. Bishop into custody based on an outstanding Detention Warrant signed by the Chairman of the Parole Board. Upon his arrest, Mr. Bishop had injuries to his forehead which were covered by bandages. After being taken into custody, Det. DiGregorio observed and had the opportunity to speak with Mr. Bishop in the presence of Attorney Paul DiMajo. Det. DiGregorio observed Mr. Bishop to be approximately 5'10" tall with a thin build and mostly salt-and-pepper, consistent with the description provided by the surviving victims.

Also on 7/3/07, a photopak was developed containing a recent photograph of Bishop without his current injuries. In the presence of Det. DiGregorio, the photopaks were shown separately to both Claire and Cesar Medeiros. Both Mr. and Mrs. Medeiros positively identified the defendant, Alfred Bishop as their attacker.

Further on 7/3/07, Det. DiGregorio applied for and had a search warrant signed by Judge Buccini at the Kent County Courthouse. The search warrant allowed Officers to obtain a DNA sample, hair samples and photographs of any and all injuries to the body of the defendant. The search warrant was also executed on this same date in the presence of Det. DiGregorio. Several cuts and bruises were noted on the defendant's body. Two deep lacerations were noted on the left side of the defendant's forehead as were two large bruises on the defendant's right forearm and upper arm, both consistent with the location and types of injuries which may have been inflicted by Mr. Medeiros to the intruder.

On 7/6/07, Det. DiGregorio and RISP Det. Barney applied for a second search warrant for a buccal swab to be obtained from the body of the defendant. This second search warrant was signed by Judge Erickson at the Kent County Courthouse and was executed on the same date at the Intake Unit of the ACI in Cranston, RI.

On 7/30/07, the Warwick Police Department received preliminary DNA results from the Department of Health's Forensic Biology Unit. Based on their preliminary findings, the defendant's DNA profile was matched with samples obtained from the ski mask and from a rocking chair located at the scene.

Based on the investigation, it is respectfully requested that the defendant be charged with, the following:

- Murder, in violation of Rhode Island General Law (RIGL) 11-23-1;
- Burglary, RIGL 11-8-1;
- Two (2) counts of ADW in a Dwelling with intent to commit Murder, RIGL 11-5-4;
- Two (2) counts of Discharging a Firearm Resulting in Injury, RIGL 11-47-3.2(b)(2), and;
- Discharging a Firearm Resulting in Death, RIGL 11-47-3.2(b)(3).
