On 12/31/06 I was advised by Dispatcher DeGuzman that Mrs. Elizabeth StAngelo had called Barrington Police to report that her 17 year old daughter [REDACTED] had come home intoxicated. It was reported that she was at an underage drinking party on County Rd. somewhere between the two bridges. It was reported that the party was at the Monroe residence. It was also reported that the adult home owner was at the party and was letting the drinking happen in her presence. I was advised that Mrs. StAngelo wanted something done about the matter.

Upon checking the IMC system, it was learned that Monroe lived at 40 County Rd. and the adult at the residence would be Kathleen Monroe. Officer Koutros and I responded to the address. As we arrived and were walking to the rear door to the first floor apartment I could hear voices inside the residence yell "the cops are here." There was a female in the driveway of the residence. After a brief conversation she went into the 1st floor apartment and got Ms. Monroe.

Ms. Monroe came outside the apartment to talk with us. Approximately 30 seconds after she was outside Nicholas Ryan came outside and wanted to be part of the conversation. He was advised to go back inside the apartment. Before I could explain to Ms. Monroe why we were there, she said that she was sorry for [REDACTED] being sick. At the time I did not know the juvenile involved first name was [REDACTED]. I asked Ms. Monroe if she had been home tonight during the party. She stated that she was home. I then asked her if she was supplying alcohol to minors. She then stated that she did not buy any alcohol and that she only had beer in the house. She then went on to say that the only people drinking in the house were over 21 years of age. She would not let us in the apartment. She then stated that the people inside the house that were drinking brought their own alcohol. She stated that she did not know [REDACTED] had been drinking and thinks that her boyfriend gave her the alcohol.

Ms. Monroe was advised that if the StAngelo's file a formal complainant that she could be charged with a crime. Ms. Monroe was advised this department would be in contact with her in the near future.

I then responded to the StAngelo residence. Upon arrival I met with Mr and Mrs. StAngelo. It was learned that their daughter [REDACTED] was very intoxicated and upstairs in the bathroom vomiting. I also spoke with [REDACTED] who stated that her sister called her for a ride home. [REDACTED] told me that she went into the apartment and found her sister in the bathroom vomiting. [REDACTED] and her boyfriend [REDACTED] had to carry [REDACTED] out of the residence because she could not walk on her own. [REDACTED] stated that she recognized some of the people in the apartment as High School senior and under the age of 21, drinking. Mr and Mrs StAngelo stated that they wanted charges press against Ms. Monroe.

They were advised that statements needed to be taken from their daughters regarding the matter and that the statement with [REDACTED] needed to be completed when she was sober. They were advised to contact Detectives on Tuesday morning for statements. I advised them that I would start the report regarding tonight's incident.

It should be noted that this department was at 40 County Rd earlier this evening at approximately 2225 hrs. two calls were received for a report of a fight in the driveway and road in front of 48 County Rd. reference call number 06-19844. Upon arrival at that time a vehicle was attempting to leave with several occupants inside and Nicholas Ryan standing outside on the sidewalk. It was reported that two subject had held the scene prior to officer arrival that had been causing the disturbance.

On January 3, 2007 I responded to 40 County Road in Barrington to speak with Kathleen Munroc and her daughter [REDACTED] Munroc. [REDACTED] and Kathleen told me about the party that [REDACTED] and her friends had at the home and how Alyson's friend [REDACTED] was taken from the home because she was too intoxicated to leave on her own. Their statement was tape recorded and is attached to this report. The description of the amount of persons in attendance at the home and the activities causing the police to respond tend to make it almost impossible for Kathleen not to know there was underage drinking activity taking place while she was present during the party her daughter held for her friends in the home. Kathleen told me that she was home all evening during the party. The apartment is a one level 4 room apartment with a small attached porch.

On 02/12/2007 I spoke with a person who had been named by [REDACTED] Munroe as being present at her party on December 31, 2006. This person has been reliable in the past with furnishing information that ultimately proved reliable for East Providence Police. This person [REDACTED] corroborated the information given to me by [REDACTED] Munroe and her mother Kathleen Munroe. The only difference between the information given by [REDACTED] and Kathleen and this person was the fact that there were numerous amounts of alcohol present during the party and that Kathleen knew about it and was actually seen by this person as placing a bottle of Vodka in the refrigerator for an underage person. This person [REDACTED] also relayed that they had consumed alcohol at least fifteen or more times at this same house in the presence of Kathleen Munroe because she allowed them to drink alcohol. This house, according to this person, became the place to hang out for numerous friends of [REDACTED]. The reporting person also indicated that a Shawn from Riverside was given the money and purchased the alcohol for the party. The reporting person indicated that there was approximately 5 (30) racks of beer, 5 litres of Vodka, and 1.75 litres of Bacardi Hurricane. This person also said that 3 vehicles showed up at the party with teens from Bristol supporting what [REDACTED] had told me.
