NARRATIVE FOR PATROLMAN RYAN J LABOISSONNIERE

On 12/01/06 at approximately 2138 hours I was dispatched to 51 Williams St. for a report of a underage drinking party. When I arrived at the residence I heard loud music and banging in the back of the residence. I proceeded to go to the back of the residence where I observed approximately 15-20 individuals scale the fence and run into the adjacent yards. Approximately 14 individuals stayed at the residence. While in the backyard I observed several Bud Light cans scattered throughout the yard in plain view.

While in the backyard I was approached by Barbara E. O'Neil (DOB 12/10/65) who stated that she is the owner of the residence. ~~O'Neil asked me to leave the backyard several times while she was trying to conceal the Bud Light cans in plain view.~~ While in the backyard of the residence I observed a "beer pong" table with a large amount of Bud Light cans on the porch of the residence. When I asked O'Neil to enter the residence she stated that she had a vicious Chow which needed to be put away before I entered. When O'Neil entered the residence I could see her throwing empty Bud Light cans away along with bottles of alcohol. I proceeded to enter the residence instructing O'Neil to stop throwing items away.

Upon entering the residence I observed another "beer pong" table with a large amount of Bud Light cans. I also observed several 1.75 Liter bottles of alcohol. While inside the residence O'Neil repeatedly stated that "we don't have to report this do we?" O/Molis and O/Ptaszek arrived on scene.

O'Neil stated that she had no knowledge that there was a gathering she had arrived at her residence ten minutes before I arrived. O'Neil stated that she had just come back from picking up two large pizzas from Papa Johns on Smithfield Ave. in Pawtucket. I observed the two large pizzas and the time on the box which the pizzas were called in was 2114 hours. O'Neil stated that when she returned from picking up the pizza her house was filled with people. O'Neil stated that her daughter [REDACTED] was supposed to have six people over tonight for her friends birthday.

[REDACTED] who was one of the parties that fled the residence when I arrived returned to the residence once her mother called her on her cellular phone. [REDACTED] stated that she was supposed to have a small get together tonight but she stated that people just kept showing up and she did not know what to do. [REDACTED] refused to divulge the names of any of the individuals who fled the residence or who bought the alcohol. I observed a napkin containing a list of alcoholic beverages lying on the kitchen table. The napkin was seized and a seizure report was completed. The napkin was placed inside the temporary evidence locker.

Officers spoke with all of the juveniles at the residence who all stated that O'Neil had arrived at the residence a few minutes before I did with the pizza. The juveniles also stated that once O'Neil arrived everyone started to scatter, but O'Neil told them to stay at the residence it was not a big deal.

In the residence was twelve minors, and three adults two of which were over twenty-one (See involved). All of the minor's parents were contacted and were picked up at the residence. The two adults were allowed to drive from the residence per O/Ptaszek. Officers had [REDACTED] empty all of the remaining alcohol into the sink while officers observed.

O/Ptaszek photographed the residence and all of the alcohol before it was disposed of. O'Neil was informed that charges may be pending upon further investigation of the incident. O'Neil stated that she is moving [REDACTED]. O'Neil stated that she can be contacted a [REDACTED].
