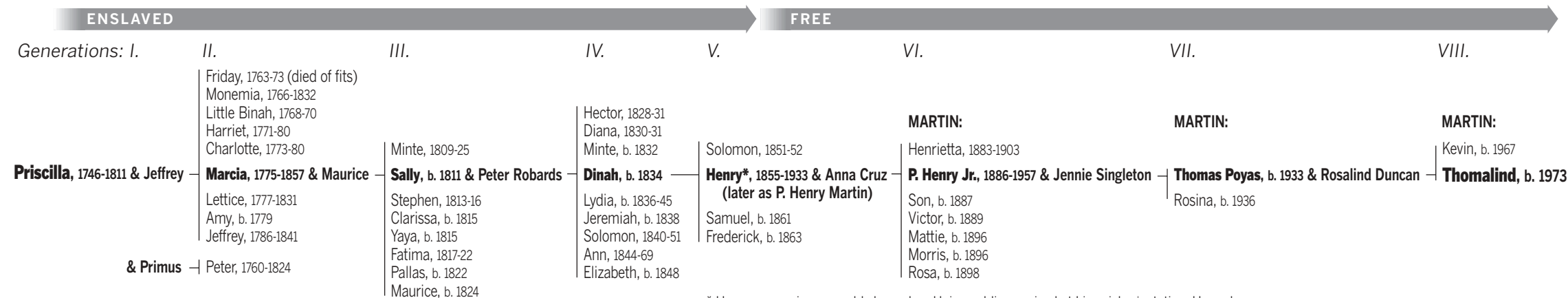


## The generational links from Priscilla to Thomalind

Rice grower Elias Ball Jr. bought a little girl he named Priscilla on June 30, 1756. From the family's records, his descendant Edward Ball was able to construct Priscilla's family tree.
